

The Applicant should be a Natural Person:

The following documents (notarized as indicated) are required from the applicant before a Freelancer Permit can be issued:

1.	Application Form.
2.	Original Qualification Certificate(s) – [copy will be accepted if notarized].
3.	Business Plan.
4.	(a) Valid passport copy of the applicant. (b) NOC from the current Residency visa Sponsor of the applicant in the U.A.E. (if applicable)
5.	Bank reference letter of the applicant.
6.	Client Information Sheet.
7.	Freelance Permit Fees. [Payments are to be made in favor of TECOM through a demand draft / cheque / cash].
8.	Original Freelancer Agreement.
9.	Signed Certificate of an Authorization for Government Services Operations (GSO).

Important Notes:

- All legal documents more than one page has to be sealed.
- Powers of Attorney need to be accompanied with a valid passport copy of the Attorney.
- The Authority reserves the right to call for any extra documents it may deem require, as and when necessary.
- The Authority reserves the right to ask for extra attestation by the UAE Embassy or other Embassies, as may be necessary.
- The legal documents must be in English and / or Arabic. Documents in any other language must be accompanied by a certified English or Arabic translation.
